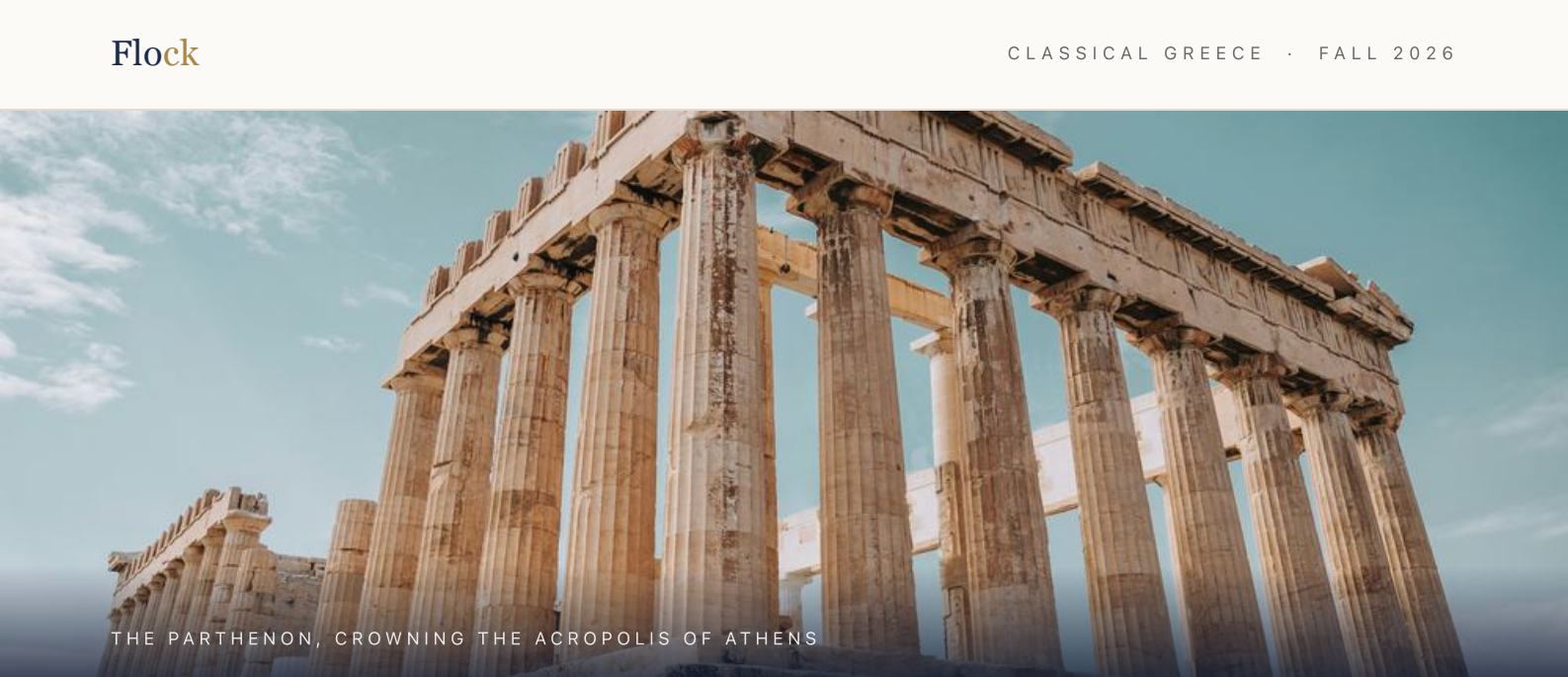

Where the Western world began.

Some journeys are measured in distance. This one is measured in centuries. Over nine days, Classical Greece moves through the landscape where theatre, philosophy, and democracy were first imagined, and where their monuments still stand under an open sky.

The route is a clean loop. You begin in Athens beneath the Acropolis, travel south into the Peloponnese, climb to the oracle at Delphi, and reach the monasteries of Meteora before turning back to the capital. The pace is considered rather than rushed, with two unhurried nights in the harbor town of Nafplio and free hours written into the schedule.

Every hotel, coach, guide, and entrance has been arranged for you by Flock, drawing on a heritage of guided group travel that reaches back to 1959. All that is left for you to do is arrive.

A clean loop through the mainland.

Classical Greece begins and ends in Athens, running south into the Peloponnese, up to the oracle at Delphi, and on to Meteora.

- ◆ **The Theatre of Epidauros**, famous still for its acoustics
- ◆ **The monasteries of Meteora**, set on summits of rock
- ◆ **The Lion Gate** at Mycenae and the Treasury of Atreus
- ◆ **The Sanctuary of Apollo** at Delphi, below Mount Parnassus
- ◆ **Nafplio** and an optional cruise across the Saronic Gulf

01 DAY ONE · ATHENS

Arrive in Athens

You are met at Athens International Airport and transferred to your hotel in the center of the city. The evening brings a welcome meeting with your guide, a short orientation walk, and a first dinner together at a traditional taverna.

02 DAY TWO · ATHENS

Athens and the Acropolis

A morning guided tour of the Acropolis, the Parthenon, the Erechtheion, and the Acropolis Museum. The afternoon and evening are yours, free for the lanes of the Plaka, the ancient Agora, and the markets of Monastiraki.

DAY THREE · THE PELOPONNESE

Into the Peloponnese

The day crosses the Corinth Canal into the Peloponnese. A guided visit to Mycenae takes in the Lion Gate and the Treasury of Atreus, followed by the Theatre of Epidauros, famous still for its acoustics. The evening settles in Nafplio with an orientation walk and dinner together.

Nafplio at Leisure

A relaxed day in one of the most elegant towns in Greece. Climb to the Palamidi fortress, wander the Venetian old town, swim at a nearby beach, or take a short boat ride out to the island castle of Bourtzi. The day is yours to keep at your own pace.

The Road to Delphi

A scenic drive climbs into the mountains of central Greece, pausing at the village of Arachova or the Byzantine monastery of Hosios Loukas. The day ends in Delphi, on the slopes of Mount Parnassus, with dinner together.

DAY SIX · DELPHI TO METEORA

Delphi and the Way North

A guided morning at Delphi: the Sanctuary of Apollo, the Temple of Apollo, the ancient theatre and stadium, and the museum with its bronze Charioteer. The route then turns north to Kalambaka, where Meteora first appears in the light of late afternoon.

Monasteries between earth and sky.

Working Eastern Orthodox communities, kept on the summits of stone.
You climb to meet them on the seventh morning of the journey.

Meteora and the Return

A morning among the monasteries of Meteora, working Eastern Orthodox communities set on the summits of rock. The road south pauses at Thermopylae and the monument to Leonidas, before an evening arrival in Athens and dinner together.

A Flexible Day

A flexible day. Join an optional cruise across the Saronic Gulf to the islands of Hydra, Poros, and Aegina, with lunch on board, or keep the day free in Athens for its museums and shops. A farewell dinner closes the evening.

International airfare to and from Athens, travel insurance, lunches and meals taken on free days and evenings, drinks, the optional Saronic Gulf cruise, gratuities for the guide and driver, and personal expenses.

Activity level: Moderate. Expect walking on uneven ancient stone, with steps and gentle hills at the archaeological sites and the Meteora monasteries. The pace is steady, with rest written into the two days in Nafplio.

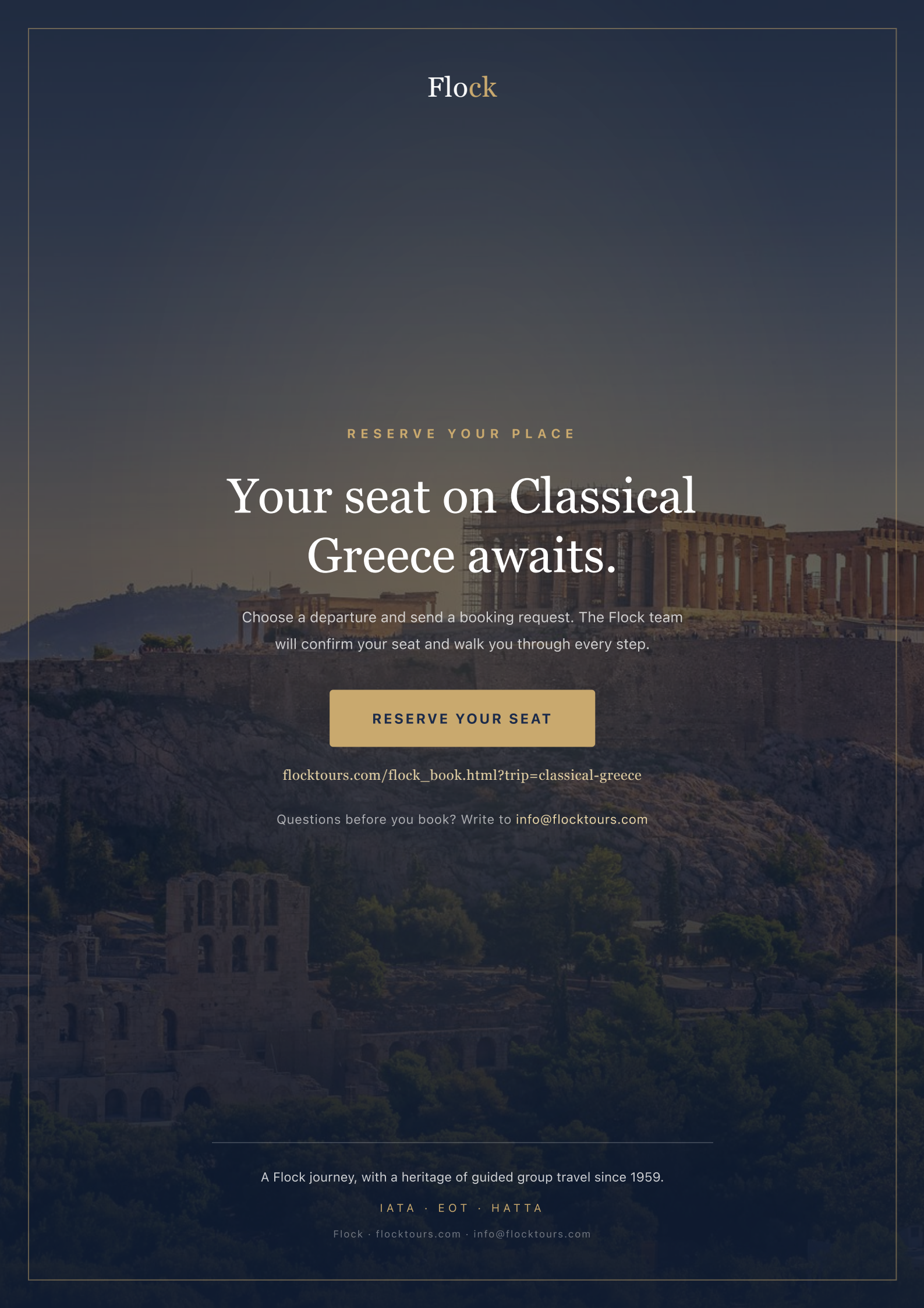
Deposit and cancellation
